

FAQ: Independent Course Providers

Are ACAC certification programs accredited?

- Yes. The CESB accredits the CIEC and CMC as engineering related programs, and the CIE, CMI, CMRS, CMR, CRMI and CIAQM as engineering technician programs. The CEICI, CEICC, CEICR, CEICS, CIER, CIES, CETI and CETC programs are pending CESB accreditation.
- The ACAC has the only third-party accredited certifications in the indoor air quality industry.

Are all ACAC certifications board-awarded?

- Yes. All certifications are awarded by a unanimous vote of a certification board of peers.

What are the course provider requirements to develop and deliver study/review courses for ACAC certifications?

- There are no requirements.
- There is no contract. There are no revenue-sharing agreements.

Does the ACAC market for course providers of certification preparatory courses?

- No. Course providers must use their own marketing skills and resources to market their courses for certification preparation.

Does the ACAC list course providers of certification preparatory courses on their website?

- Yes. ACAC lists exam prep course providers in a searchable database at www.acac.org in exchange for a simple registration form. There is no fee for registration; however, there is a \$100 fee for a direct hyperlink to the course provider website.

Does the ACAC offer study/review courses?

- No. The ACAC does not conduct study/review courses using in-house personnel or contracted providers.

Who can be a course provider for an ACAC certification study/review course?

- Any individual, company or organization may develop and deliver a study/review course for an ACAC certification.
